Dance Club

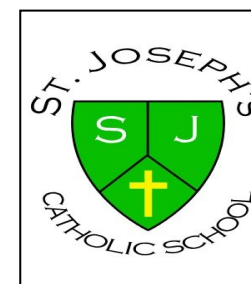
Dance club are currently preparing for their performance at Pendle Festival.
