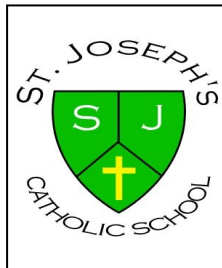

Class councils have been holding elections to choose the new school councillors. We are delighted that we have elected new councillors in each year group and would like to congratulate them.

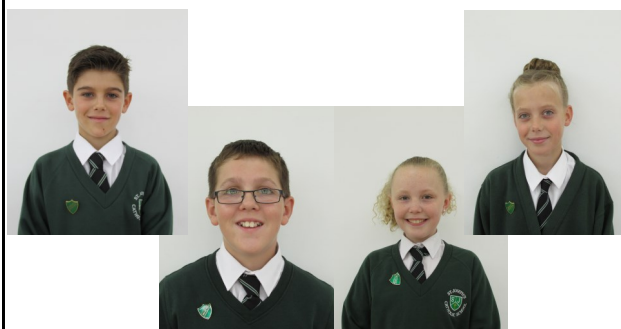
Our school council meet each term to discuss ideas the children put forward during class council meetings, to look at ways to regularly improve our school.

Our new children are settling into Class 1 and are already enjoying our lovely outdoor area, having fun and making lots of new friends.

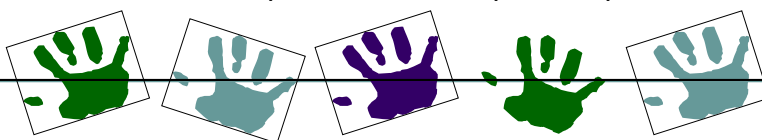
Head Boy, Head Girl, Deputy Head Boy/Girl 2016-2017.
