

everyone who sent in ideas and suggestions!




ParentPay

We accept Childcare Vouchers!

You should now be able to access ParentPay to book your breakfast and after school club places and you need to book 7 DAYS IN ADVANCE using the "Make Bookings" link as highlighted in the screenshot.

Please make sure you have chosen the correct day and time, either 3.15-4.45 or 3.15-6.00, so that we can plan and prepare food and age appropriate activities in advance. If you are having trouble accessing ParentPay, or are struggling to make bookings, please contact the school office so that we can help you to get started.
